Requirements when submitting new technologies for addition to the eligible technology list

- Salix recognises that new energy-efficiency technologies emerge over time, and therefore is open to reviewing any that public sector organisations wish to implement in order to assess their suitability for Salix funding.
- New technologies will only be reviewed where they have been submitted for consideration by a public sector organisation. This ensures that technologies are added only when there is a level of demand that public sector organisations would like to access Salix funding streams for this technology.
- / The public sector organisation would need to provide us with the following information in order for Salix and its external technical consultants to complete a full review of the technology:
 - Details of the specific project for which the public sector body is seeking Salix funding, including a project description, details of energy savings projected and firm quotes;
 - A detailed technical explanation of how the technology works;
 - Technical specifications for the equipment (including any relevant testing standards);
 - Independent evidence of how savings are achieved;
 - Projected savings should be based on site-specific calculations. While case studies can be useful, they alone are not sufficient to support savings projections.
